# Artist Statement and Bio – Made in California

I am a Mexican-Japanese American non-binary painter and illustrator from Long Beach, California whose work centers multicultural identity and queer visibility. My work is often a reflection of my community and response to my environment. Painting, printmaking, digital media, and collage are some of the ways I explore portraiture in my art practice. Currently, my paintings depict how I navigate vulnerability, nostalgia, and empowerment.

I received my B.A. in Studio Art from California State University, of Long Beach, with an emphasis in Illustration. My work has been exhibited in Sur:biennial's 2019 *Generational:Local Latinx LGBTQIA Artists* group exhibition at the Long Beach City College Art Gallery. I was a featured artist for Long Beach Artwalk, OUT LOUD LB Fest, and RAW Los Angeles Presents REFLECT showcase. I am a visual artist for the Arts Council of Long Beach and LA Metro's Artist Pool. Currently, I am creating new works for my upcoming solo show, *Tough to Be Tender*.

Tough and Tender is a self-portrait that describes the experience of my non-binary identity. Crossing my arms while nude represents strength in vulnerability and the dysphoria I have with my breasts. My figure gazes directly at the viewer while standing in front of hanging passion flowers against a colorful abstract background. Because the flowers are double-sexed and typically yellow, white, and lavender in appearance, colors associated with the non-binary flag in the LGBTQ community, I included them to symbolize this connection. My portrait rejects the gender binary by allowing myself to exist between what is considered feminine and masculine while also embracing the notion of where I am both tough and tender.
